Theme Park Project



Now that you are an expert on your selected country, you will describe and design a theme park that reflects your country's history, culture, and geography.

Your theme park should include:

1. A Ride (roller coaster, water ride, etc.)

- This ride should reflect your country's geography, landforms, rivers, or natural wonders.

You will need to describe the following:

- The name of your ride.
- Describe what it does, how fast it goes, etc.
- Describe what it looks like and how it represents your country.

Example for China

Name of the Ride: *Rolling Great Wall*

The *Rolling Great Wall* is a lightning fast roller coaster! It goes up to 85 miles per hour. Like the Great Wall, this rollercoaster will send you on a swooping adventure as you roll up and down the green mountains. Every time you drop, you feel like you're falling down the ancient steps of China's Great Wall! This ride will knock your socks off!

The *Rolling Great Wall* is a vibrant red color like the beautiful China flag. It has silver, textured seats that were inspired by the rocky steps of the Great Wall, but are incredibly comfortable to sit on! Interestingly, each door has a golden dragon to symbolize the "good luck" that the Chinese culture hopes to pass onto you!

2. A Restaurant

- This restaurant should reflect your country's culture, or agriculture. You will need to describe the following:
 - The name of your restaurant.
 - Describe what type of food is sold.
 - Describe it's most popular dish, and how much it costs.

Example for China:

Name of the Restaurant: The Golden Rice Temple

Spicy, delicious, and sizzling! The Golden Rice Temple serves mouth-watering rice bowls that are made from some of China's most fresh ingredients. Each bowl is made with white rice that is grown from the lovely city, Nanjing, and with fresh produce from local farmers.

3. A Show

 - What kind of music will it have? Will they be wearing traditional clothing?

Example for China:

Name of the show: *Dancing Lions*

This dance is traditionally performed on Chinese new Year, however, at Chinese Wonders theme park, you are able to witness this performance every day.

4. A Souvenir Shop

Example for China:
